MACHINE FIELD SURVEY

EXPLANATION OF PURPOSE

The InOne Technology Field Survey Form is used to record ALL machines on each route.

The completed survey will contain machines that both do and do not have DEX capability. Our engineers will analyze the list and determine the parent manufacturer's software upgrades and cables necessary to update all DEX capable equipment, but as well, all non-DEX capable machines, which appear to require our DEX upgrade kit.

Machines are recorded by your Asset number, because that is the number which will be programmed into the DEX so the machine can identify itself to your vending software. It is important that each machine's asset number correspond to your vending software's assigned asset number. During the DEX field certification and update process it may be worthwhile to label each machine with its asset number. Some operations are using bar coded labels for that

purpose or duct-tape and indelible marker. ASC will provide a computerized report, from your machine lists, for your technicians to use as their DEX certification check list.

To determine which of your machines have DEX capabilities please refer to the ASCKnown Resident DEX Machine list. IF THE MACHINE IS ON THE LIST YOU NEED ONLY RECORD the MAKE AND MODEL#. IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO INDICATE THE COIN MECHANISM OR VALIDATOR MAKE AND MODEL, IF THE MACHINE IS LISTED.

IF THE MACHINE IS NOT LISTED, RECORD ITS COIN MECH AND BILL
